



INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING PAYMENT OF SEMESTER FEE & BUS FEE

A. PAYMENT OF SEMESTER FEE

TWO METHODS FOR PAYMENT OF TUITION FEE

1. E-FEE PAYMENT

We introduced **E-Fee payment** procedure from **2013** onwards. With this method **any parent or student can pay fee all over India in any of the Federal Bank branch without an account.**

Payment Procedure

Take printout of E-fee Challan (http://jecc.ac.in/documents/Challan.pdf) from our college website and fill in the details such as branch name, date, fee details, student's name, batch name, student's admission number (
Admission number is printed in the identity card of each student below the name of the student). Fill the admission number with utmost care because it is the basis of all transaction. Produce the filled challan in any of the nearest federal bank and make payment.

2. EASY PAYMENT (ONLINE SYSTEM FOR PAYING FEES)

The Fednet facility of Federal Bank is available to pay your tuition fee, hostel fee etc.

This method is available from January 2016 onwards. It helps you to pay the college fees without going to the bank. Payment can be done through the net banking facility of any bank or through Visa/ Master Cards - Debit Cards and Credit Cards. There is no charge for this transaction through Fed-net. Other banks might levy a small fee as bank charges.





Payment procedure :-

From website use the link Easy Payments. This opens the window of Federal Bank Easy payments. You can create a user ID and password by clicking in the option New User?. If you are an existing user provide the credentials and Sign In. Then from right side select "Add payee" and add the admission number of the student. After that you can view the list of fee due in Tuition fee and hostel fee under the tab Payment. Select the appropriate fee and make payment by selecting the bank.

You can track the payment details in the payment history tab.

B. PAYMENT OF BUS FEE

Payment of bus fee is to be received at Federal bank Ext. Counter situated in the college campus from 10 a.m. to 3.30 p.m. Students are advised to take white challan from the Accounts office and remit the fee in time for the easiest transaction of bus pass and avoiding fine.
